OVERVIEW

Transitional housing is a step in the pathway towards permanent housing. It is more long-term, service-intensive and private than emergency shelters, yet remains time-limited. It is meant to provide a safe, supportive environment where residents can overcome trauma and begin to address the issues that led to homelessness or kept them homeless, and begin to rebuild their support network. Clients typically stay in transitional housing 60-90 days before they are housed in Permanent Supportive Housing.
